



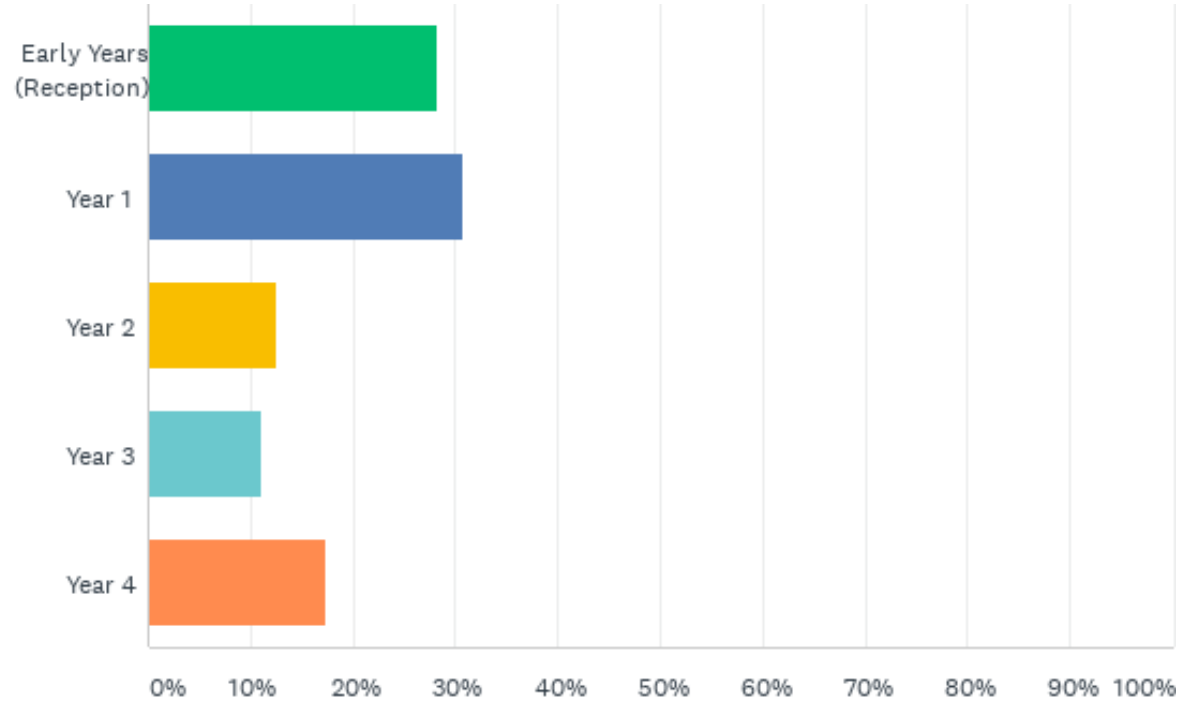

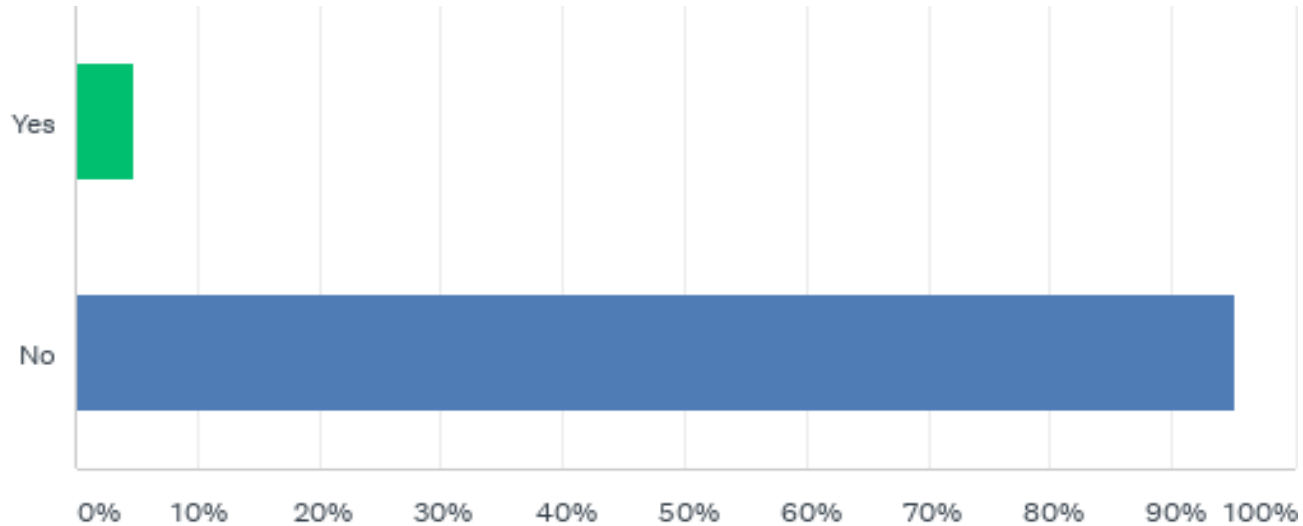

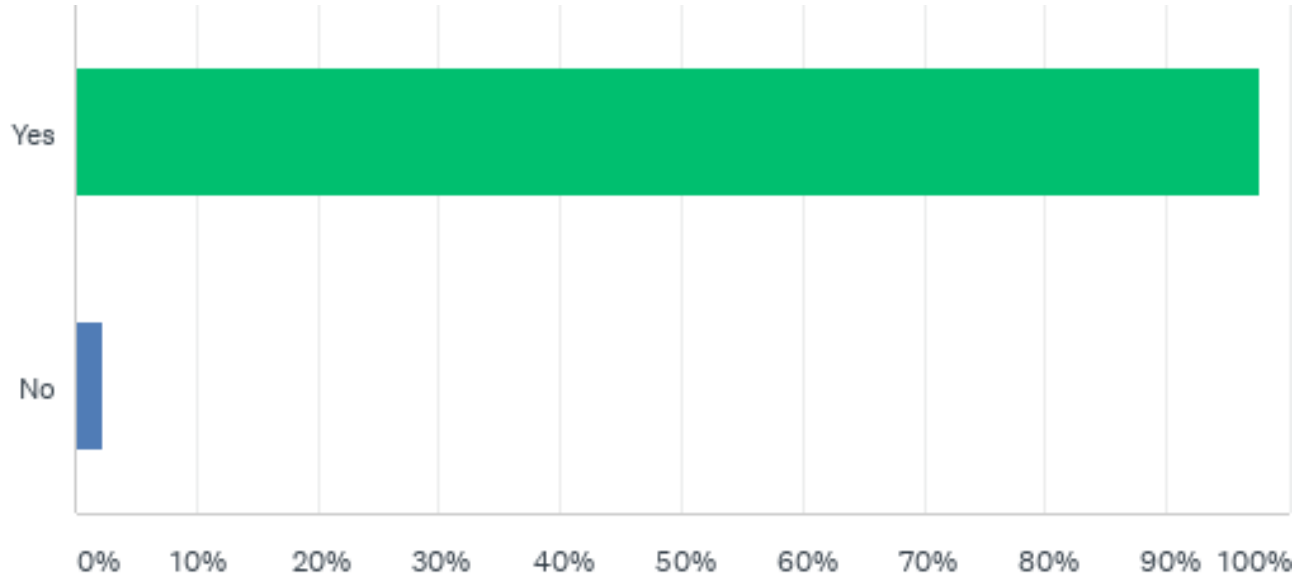

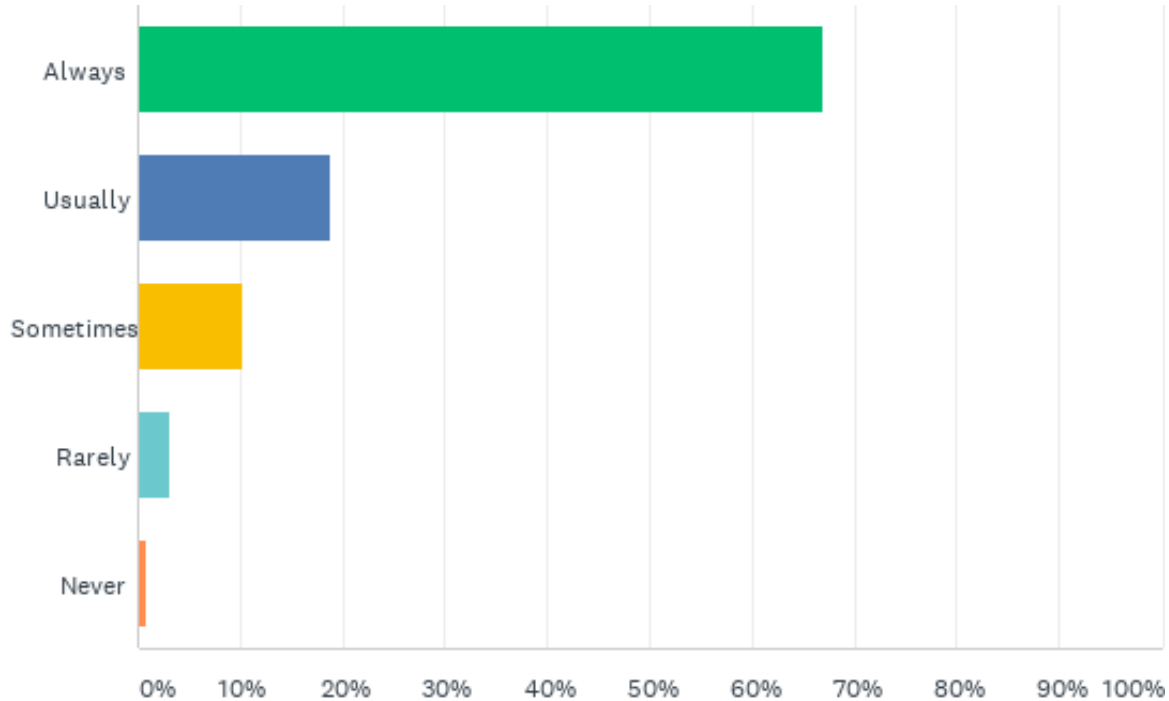

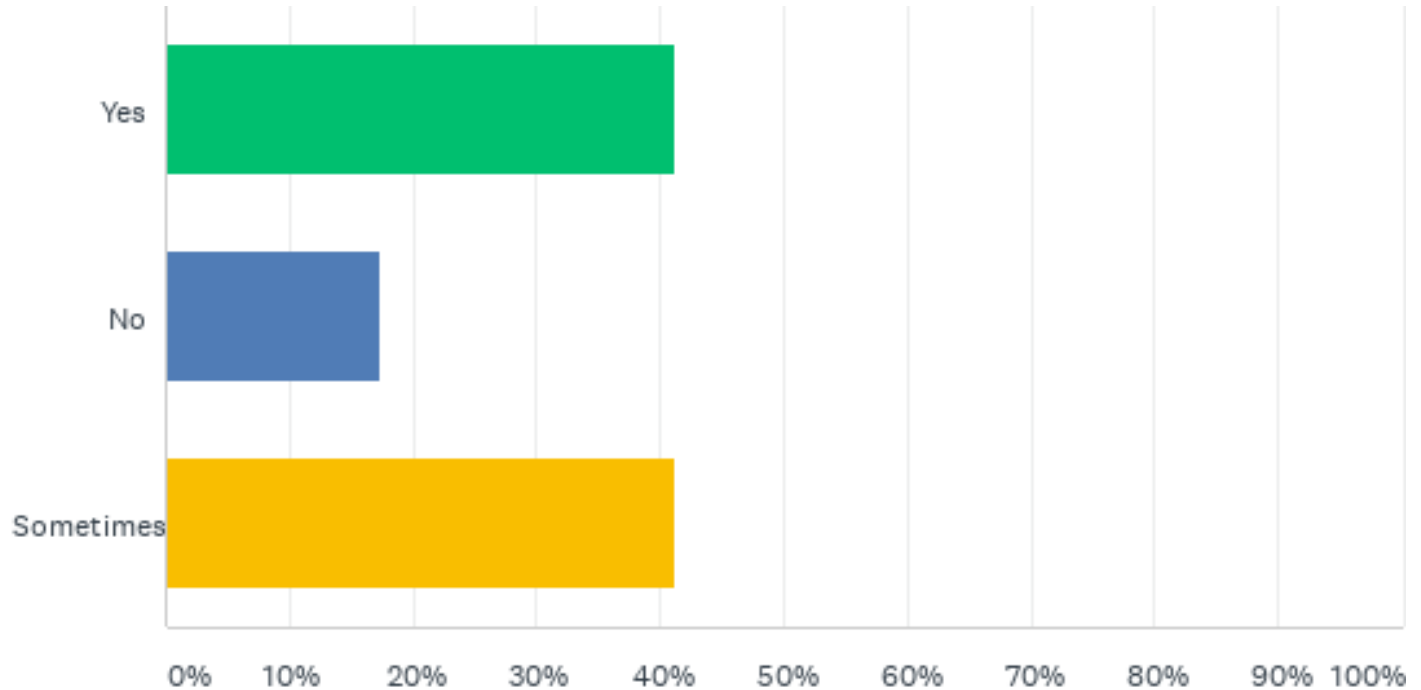

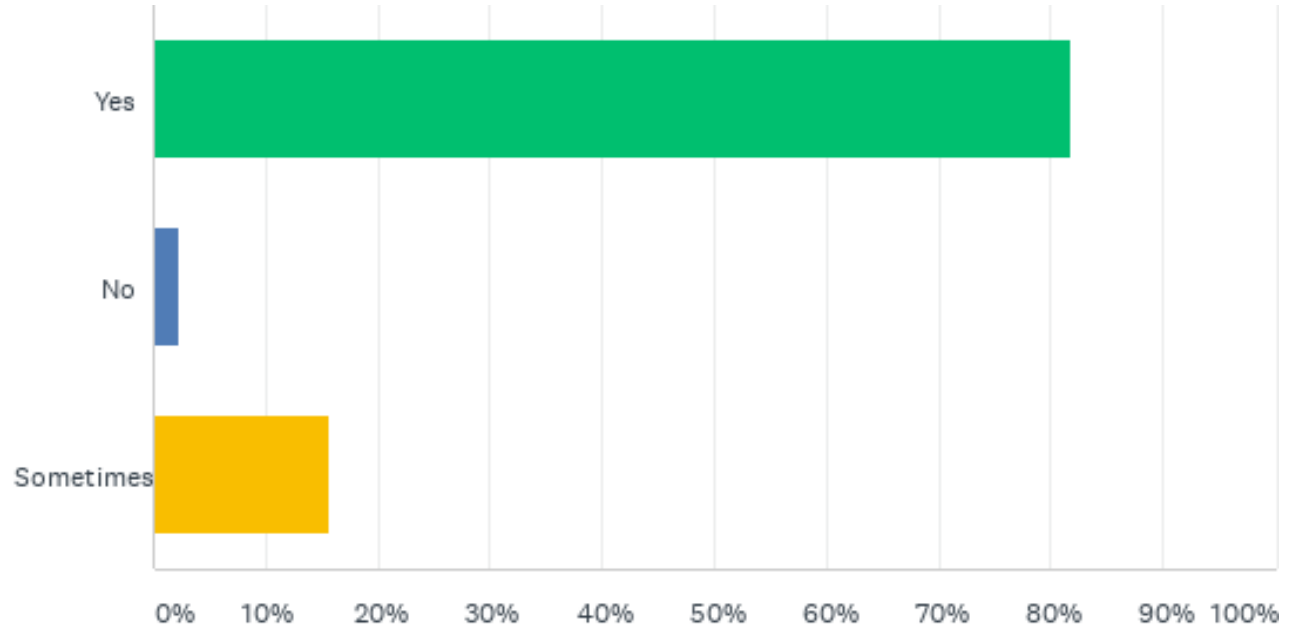

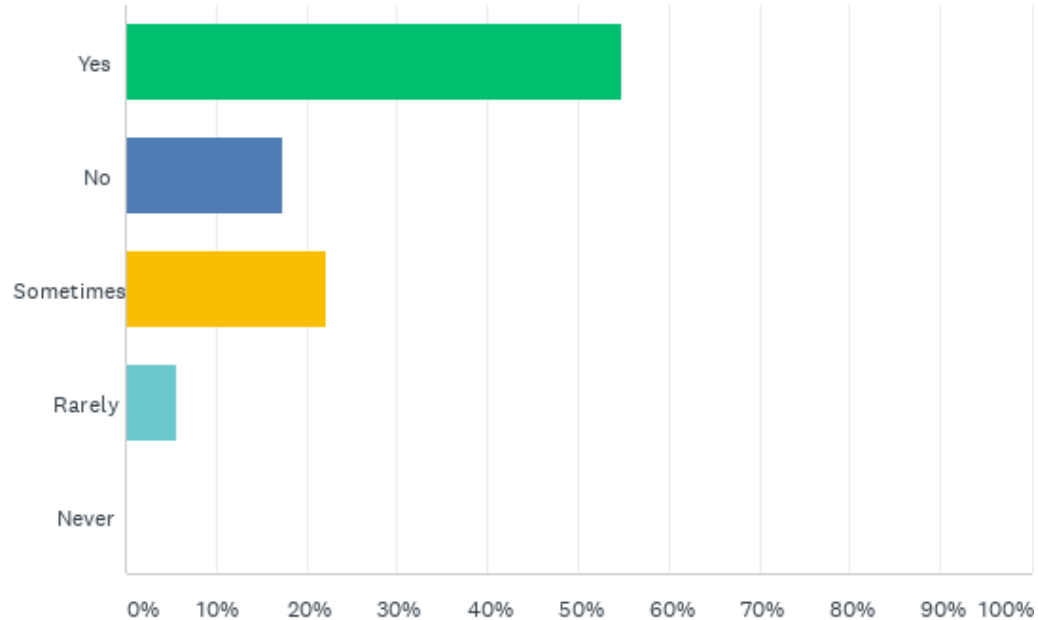

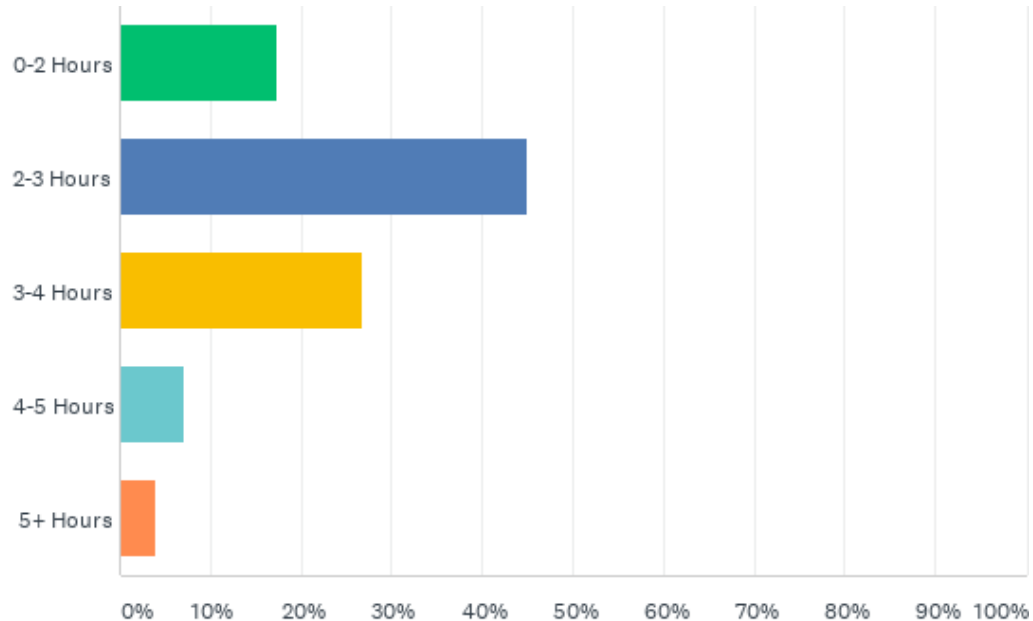
Q9: Do you feel that there is a good balance between on screen and off-screen learning?
